FAGOWEE ELECTIONS May 3, 2011

It's that time of year again when we select the future leaders of our club. We will be electing a president and vice president, both for one-year terms, and four board members, three for two-year terms, one for a one-year term. To be eligible for office, a member must be a member in good standing, at least 21 years of age, a member for the 12 months immediately prior to the election and a member for a total of at least 18 months. We received nominations at the March meeting and will accept additional nominations at the April meeting. Bill Steinhour was nominated for President; Stacy Hickman and John McIntire were nominated for Vice President; and Rich Kavanagh, Manny Raffaele, Jim Starr and Marc Vignerot were nominated for the board. All indicated that they accept their nominations. Again, please keep in mind that Andrea Steinhour and Speedy Carder were elected last year for two-year terms on the board. Therefore, they should not be nominated for the board this year. They may, of course, be nominated for President or Vice President.

As usual, voting will be by secret ballot of all voting members present at the meeting or by absentee ballot. Any member not able to attend the May 3rd election may vote by absentee ballot. However, we must receive requests for absentee ballot either by mail or by E-mail on or before April 5th! The requests may also be handed to Tim Gordon at the April 5th meeting. 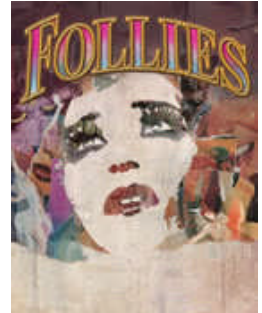

Great conditions greeted twenty lucky Fagowees on their trip to Utah. Our weather was partly cloudy and high 20s the first two days. Monday night presented a blizzard that dropped 8-15 inches on the three mountains for some of the "greatest snow on Earth," making Tuesday a fantastic powder day. We then had mostly clear, sunny days for the rest of our ski week.



We stayed at The Yarrow Hotel just three stops from the Park City Mountain base and a seven minute ride from The Canyons' base. Deer Valley was only a 15 minute ride away. We found the location very convenient and the amenities of the hotel very nice. Most enjoyed the bar, hot tub, and gym on a daily basis. We were especially happy with the daily breakfast buffet, enabling us to fuel up and get out to the mountains for first chair (or second chair). Getting into town was easy too.

An impromptu Superbowl party in Pam and Lance's room saw about half the group drop by for at least a couple of plays. Others went to one of the Superbowl parties on Main Street. The welcome party was Monday night at the Yarrow's ballroom. We enjoyed a southwestern buffet and beer, wine, and cocktails. About 3:00pm the wind began to pick up and snow began to fall – by the time of the party PC was in white out conditions. Only a few brave souls sought out Park City's nightlife after the party.

Tuesday was a powder day and our group spread out over all three mountains, several heading for The Canyons. Four of us met up with fellow Fagowees, Scott and Liz P, who were staying at that mountain with some friends. It was a beautiful day to float in the powder (or dig out of it, for those of us not as adept). We were impressed with The Canyons many renovations and pleased with some of the things that remained the same – uncrowded day lodges for lunch, a few reasonable food prices, some wide open groomers and some challenging tree runs.
